Are you looking for an alternative to school or college? Would you like to gain key employability skills whilst studying for a qualification that will help you in your future career? Our study programmes can help you achieve your goals.

Your personalised study programme includes:

- A City & Guilds vocational qualification (ranging from Level 1 - Level 3)
- Functional skills including English and maths
- Employability skills
- Work experience
- Progression opportunities

Work-Based Study Programmes give young people the opportunity to access qualifications and gain the skills and experience that employers are looking for. Our programmes help to boost career prospects with an apprenticeship or other employment in the future. Study programmes are available for young people aged 16 to 19, or up to age 24 for a learner with an EHCP.

You can start a study programme with DART at any time within the academic year. It would take up to 36 weeks to complete, studying 2 - 3 days per week.
